

TERMINAL CLEANING AND FOGGING OF ISOLATION ROOM

1. When notified that an isolation room has been vacated, obtain from Housekeeping the cart of equipment necessary for spraying the room.
2. **Fogger-Sprayer**
 - (a) Unhook base of sprayer and place 35 ml of **Melrose Deamy or Multi-Phen** in base of the sprayer. Fill remainder of base with water.
 - (b) Set delivery rate at 6 litres per hour or medium.
 - (c) Set automatic timer at one minute for each 5 to 10 cubic metres in the room. (Twelve minutes is ample time for any of our one or two bedrooms.)
3. Put on an isolation gown and mask, and enter the room.
4. If sheets are on bed, remove, put in isolation bag.
5. **Fogger-Sprayer**
 - (a) Place sprayer on turntable at table height in centre of room.
 - (b) Open all closet, locker or bathroom doors, and all drawers.
 - (c) Set venetian blind slats parallel to floor.
 - (d) Turn on sprayer and leave the room.
6. Remove gown and mask; put them in isolation bag. Wash hands.
7. Allow mist in room to settle 30 minutes after sprayer shuts off. Use of a dehumidifier may speed settling of mist.
8. Put on an isolation gown and mask and return to the room about 45 minutes after you have turned the sprayer on. (12 minutes spraying time plus 30 minutes settling time). Open the windows and air the room for 30 minutes. Do not stay in room while airing.
9. Remove gown and mask-put them in isolation bag. Wash hands.
10. After the room has aired, mix a solution of **Melrose Deamy or Multi-Phen** at 1 to 250 and, with this solution, clean the following thoroughly:
 - (a) Windows
 - (b) Venetian blinds
 - (c) Mattress cover and pillow cover
 - (d) Bathroom
11. Clean thoroughly all horizontal surfaces of:
 - (a) Bed
 - (b) Overbed Table
 - (c) Bedside Cabinets
 - (d) Bedside lamp
 - (e) Chairs
12. Wash with a solution of **Melrose Deamy or Multi-Phen** at 1 to 250 anything else in the room which has a horizontal surface.
13. Wash with a solution of **Melrose Deamy or Multi-Phen** at 1 to 250 any area in the room which shows any visible amount of soil or possible prior contamination.
14. Mop floor with clean mop and a wash with a solution of **Melrose Deamy or Multi-Phen** at 1 to 250.
15. Clean equipment used, replace on cart, and return cart to Housekeeping Office.
